

# Meet Mylo

Ashley first came to The Yard during an incredibly difficult time. After losing her former partner to suicide, she was struggling to support her five-year-old son, Mylo, who became overwhelmed in busy or noisy places and is waiting for an assessment for ADHD and autism.



Most mainstream groups felt impossible, and without a diagnosis, Ashley didn't know where to turn.

A friend suggested The Yard, and although Ashley arrived anxious and unsure she'd be welcome, the team immediately put her at ease.

"From the minute we walked in, I realised this was the first place that understood us." Now, Ashley and her four children visit every Sunday, and the difference has been transformative. Mylo has space for sensory play, access to the toys and equipment that help him feel safe, and the freedom to explore without judgement.

**"At The Yard, he can relax, be himself and actually have fun."**

The impact has touched the whole family. Ashley's older children have learned how to play with Mylo in ways that bring them closer together, and Ashley has found emotional support at a time when she needed it most.
