Welcome to our EDAN Hub Newsletter! We have had a busy start to 2026 with lots of appointments and sessions happening at the EDAN Hub. Occupational Therapy and Speech and Language Therapy joined our play team at their play sessions for some food exploration – this has been another successful joining of services!

We continue to receive lovely feedback from you all about what is working well. We really welcome your feedback so please do let us know if something went well or if there is anything we can improve! We're aware that finding the right pathway to support for social and wellbeing needs has been difficult so we've created a summary of supports, including contact details to try and help. Please see the attachment - we have also added this to our website.

At EDAN Hub, families can access support from a team of over 40 professionals across seven services. Together, we aim to provide an understanding community, play spaces, and helpful information and guidance to support strong, connected communities where children, young people, and families feel a sense of belonging.




We want to hear from you!

We are changing our name.....



We're updating our name to be more accurate with our language choices. In addition to families affected by disability, our mission is to help, and our services are for, children and young people (and their families) who are neurodivergent - who think, learn and communicate in a different way from the majority. Whilst we value and embrace our place in a neurodiverse society, our role is to offer support to the neurodivergent. There's no change to any of the criteria for our services and many remain available to families regardless of whether they currently have a formal diagnosis or identification.

Fortunately the EDAN acronym still works (phew!), however our full name going forward will be :

Edinburgh Disability and Neurodivergence Hub.
